

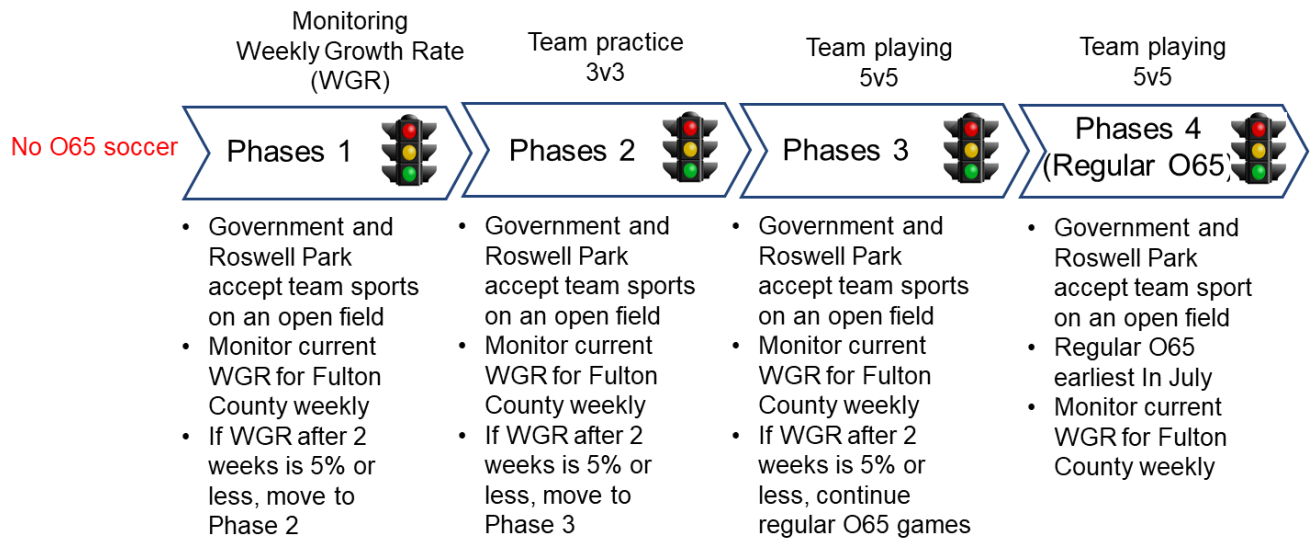
# Epidemic / Pandemic Guidelines and Waiver

Our way to go through epidemic / pandemic should not be emotionally driven, our way should be rationally driven.

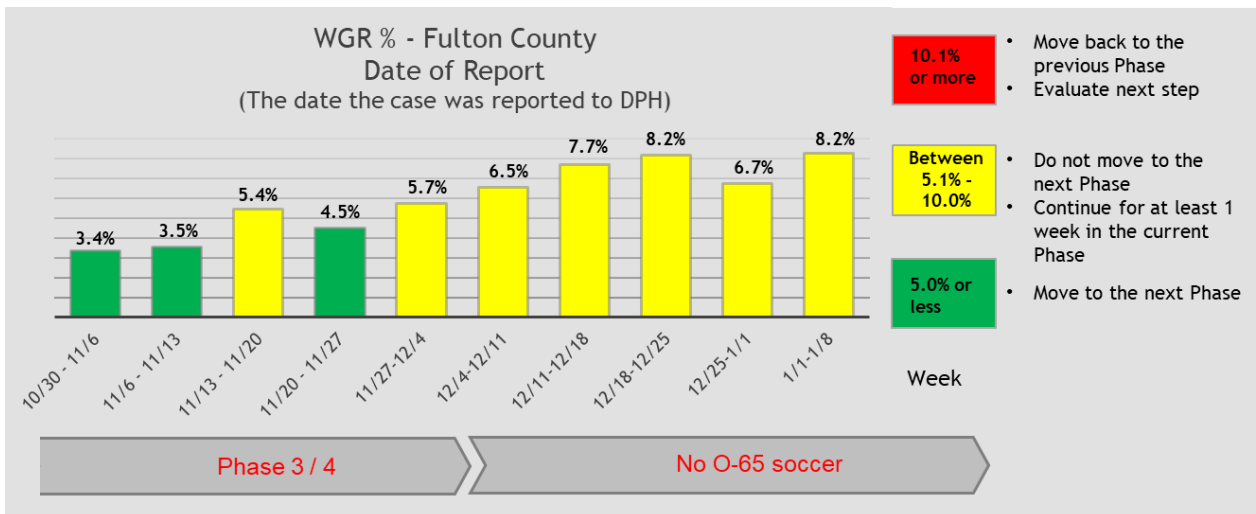
### Method

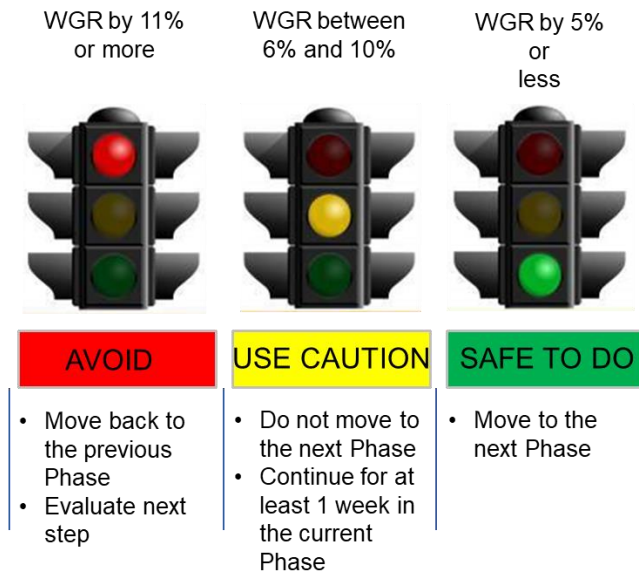
The method below is an example of how the Division will create guidelines in case of an epidemic / pandemic.



### Traffic lights tell us what we have to do

Traffic light is weekly controlled by growth rate for Fulton County and advice from the Fulton County commissioner and Roswell Park and reported to the O65 once a week every Friday evening.





## Social distancing is the key

- Social distancing is the practice of reducing close contact between people to slow the spread of infection or diseases.
- Social distancing measures include limiting large groups of people coming together, closing buildings, and cancelling events.

## Weekly monitoring the growth rate (WGR)

Example: Fulton County cases

### Current situation – January 8/2021

- Week Friday, January 1 to Friday, January 8, **traffic light is yellow**
- Increasing to last week: 1.5% ... wear a mask, watch your distance!!!
- Weekly cases per 100k: 426.5 ... increasing to last week: 99.4 cases!

The Georgia Department of Public Health's published daily report as a source for this report. In this report, the numbers are available for each county. Of course, the percentage calculated for each week says nothing about possible infections in a group. This number can therefore only be regarded as a guideline for a possible infection potential for Fulton County.
